The selection of the suitable gloves does not only depend on the material, but also on further marks of quality and varies from manufacturer to manufacturer. As the product is a preparation of several substances, the resistance of the glove material can not be calculated in advance and has therefore to be checked prior to the application.

Penetration time of glove material

For the mixture of chemicals mentioned below the penetration time has to be at least 480 minutes (Permeation according to EN 16523-1:2015: Level 6).

The exact break through time has to be found out by the manufacturer of the protective gloves and has to be observed.
